NEW JERSEY:

The following shall be considered legal holidays--New Year's Day; Martin Luther King Jr's Birthday, the third Monday in January; Lincoln's Birthday, February 12; Washington's Birthday, the third Monday in February; Good Friday; Memorial Day, the last Monday in May; Independence Day, July 4; Labor Day, the first Monday in September; Columbus Day, the second Monday in October; Veterans' or Armistice Day, November 11; Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November; Christmas Day, December 25; any general election day in the State; and any day appointed by the governor of the state or by the U.S. President as a holiday. When any of these holidays falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday for state employees. When any of these holidays falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be deemed a public holiday. New Jersey Revised Statutes, Sec. 36:1-1.2, as amended by Ch. 65, L. 1977 and Chap. 135, L. 1978
